MASS INTENTIONS

The Deep End - Curioser and curioser

'Alice opened the door and found that it led into a small passage, not much larger than a rat-hole: she knelt down and looked along the passage into the loveliest garden you ever saw. How she longed to get out of that dark hall, and wander about among those beds of bright flowers and those cool fountains, but she could not even get her head though the doorway.' (Lewis Carroll: *Alice's Adventures in Wonderland*)

In the opening chapter of *Alice's Adventures in Wonderland*, Alice is having a bit of bother with doors. She finds herself in a hall in which the doors are all locked. When she finds a key, it doesn't fit the locks. When she manages to find a door to match the key, she herself won't fit - the door is too narrow. How frustrating!

Today's Gospel parable features a narrow door, a locked door, and an unsympathetic doorkeeper – it's almost as if the master wants to keep everyone out! People knock on the door expecting to be admitted, but it's not that simple. The master turns them away, claiming not to know them, despite protestations that they are acquainted. Jesus is teaching His followers about discipleship. What does He mean by <we must 'enter by the narrow door'>? Is it almost impossible to enter the kingdom of God? One thing is sure: a passing acquaintance with Jesus will not do. A plea, 'We once ate and drank in your company' is feeble. It's not enough to know Jesus only on the surface – to attend Mass every Sunday or turn to Him only when in need. To really know Jesus, we must walk the narrow path of the Gospel.


